# Introduction to Philosophy of Religion (3)

An introduction to philosophical thinking about religion, with an emphasis on issues central to traditional monotheism. This course teaches how to critically examine arguments concerning the

origin of religion, the existence of God, the historicity of miracles, the veridicality of religious and mystical experience,

the existence of spirits or souls, the possibility of life after death, the equal validity of all religions, and other topics. (Skyline College)

## Introduction to Social and Political Philosophy (3)

Major philosophical issues surrounding the nature of society and justifications for the authority of the state. Focuses on how the concepts of the common good, individual rights, liberty, equality, and democracy relate to notions of justice, private property and the legitimate use of state power.
